Your continued support over the past year has helped us support those in need in our community.

OUR CLIENTS

- A total of 43,925 household visits
- 9% single parent households, while 46% were single person households
- Visual minorities made up 66% of our clients
- 7% were post-secondary students
- Most commonly spoken languages: Mandarin, Ukrainian, Cantonese, Tagalog, Russian, Spanish
- Most common ethnicities: White, Chinese, Filipino, Latin American

OTHER IMPACT

- For every \$1 donated, we were able to provide \$7 worth of food
- Individual contributions made up 38% of total monetary donations
- 16% of total food donations were from community members and groups
- 230 volunteers contributed 48,000 volunteer hours, which is equivalent to 27 FTEs
