

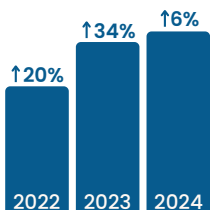

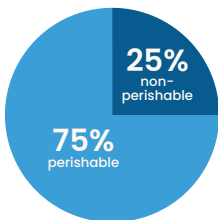

CLIENT DEMOGRAPHICS

- On average, 1,225 households served each week
- Seniors (65+) accessing our services increased by 19% compared to 2023
- 18% of our clients are school-aged children (ages 5-17) and 8% of our clients are post-secondary students
- Most commonly spoken languages: English, Ukrainian, Mandarin, Cantonese, Tagalog, Spanish
- Most common ethnicities: White, Chinese, Filipino, Latin American, South Asian, West Asian

YOUR IMPACT

- \$5.1 million worth of food recovered and 1,230,560kgs of CO2 emissions saved
- 612 meal kits distributed to school aged children through the Brighter Days, Fuller Plates campaign
- Individual contributions made up 30% of total monetary donations
- 198 volunteers contributed 26,800 volunteer hours, equivalent to 15 FTEs
- 71 volunteer groups contributed a total of 1,204 volunteer hours
